## Sessions

Time: Sessions typically range from 30–90 minutes. The average time for your child's session, however, will depend on their strengths and treatment needs.

Focus: We focus on intense therapy that incorporates your child's natural interests which are playful and FUN!

Location/Setting: We offer our services in settings that your child would encounter during their normal day. We travel to your child's preschool, daycare, home, or a pre-determined community-based location. We also offer space for therapy in our clinic.

## Payments

Medicaid: We accept Montana Medicaid and Healthy Montana Kids (HMK) Plus.

Private Pay: If your child does not have Medicaid, we charge a flat rate for our sessions.

Private Insurance: We accept a variety of private insurance plans, some of which include Allegiance, First Choice Health, Montana Health Co-Operative, Pacific Source, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Montana and Tricare.
